Deliverables

A written report is to be furnished to the Benton Foundation with respect to all expenditures under the grant no later than 60 days after the completion of the project. The written report, signed by an appropriate officer of your organization, should contain:

- A final financial statement with respect to all expenditures made under the grant; and
- A narrative account of what was accomplished by the expenditure of funds, including progress made toward achieving the goals of the grant and an assurance that the activities under the grant have been conducted in conformity with the terms of the grant.

Controlling Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia.

It is also understood that your organization confirms its status both as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and as a publicly supported organization, not a private foundation, under Section 509 (a). Your organization also confirms that neither status has been revoked or modified. If either status has been revoked or modified, please notify the foundation.
