1. TMC

- --will pass through \$25,000 in restricted grant money from the Wyncote Foundation to fund reporting by TMC members for this project, with the selection and number of members to be decided by the Project Advisory Committee.
- -- will make staffer Erin Polgreen available to join in calls with TMC projec t members.
- --will assist WTP in publicity and outreach efforts.

2. WTP

- --will hire Tracy Van Slyke as Project Manager
- --will manage the production of reportage and coordinate publication/airing of reports so that reports created for this project appear within a two-week window.
- --will take the lead on publicizing project content in consultation with the Project Advisory Committee

VI. Values

TMC and WTP agree to uphold the following values over the course of this project:

- a. Grants of money to TMC members will be made using a process that is open and transparent.
- b. Multi-platform reportage will be preferred to single platform reports; however, no single medium will be preferred over any other.
- c. Decision-making for this project will prioritize the impact reportage will have on the public.
- d. TMC funds must be spent during fiscal year 2011.
